
## "The Cheerful Giver"

"Each of you must give as you have made up your mind, not regretfully or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." 2 Corinthians 9:7




In an effort to keep everyone up to date on the Church's Finances, we will be making updates available as to how we are doing with the 2025 Budget. This current chart includes the 1<sup>st</sup> 7 weeks of the year and the "Giving" numbers represent Congregational Giving. Other income from outside sources are not reflected. Please note that the annual budgeted figures are converted to weekly amounts, which is not reflective of how the income and expenses flow, as not everything comes in or out in fifty-two equal installments.
